# Learning modules

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**Assignment submission**

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### How do students submit a Turnitin assignment?

In order to submit a Turnitin assignment, students must first locate the assignment link in your module and click **View Assignment**. This is why we advise setting this up in the **Assignments** content area, so it is easy to find.

If you have followed our recommended settings, then students can resubmit as many times as they want until the due date. The submission process is the same each time, but there may be a delay of up to 48 hours to regenerate the similarity report.



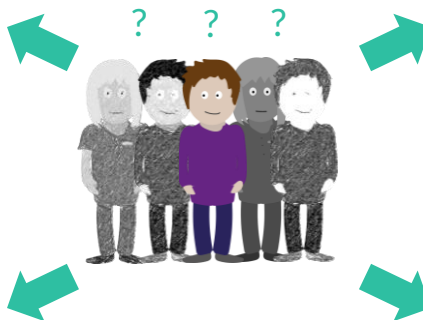

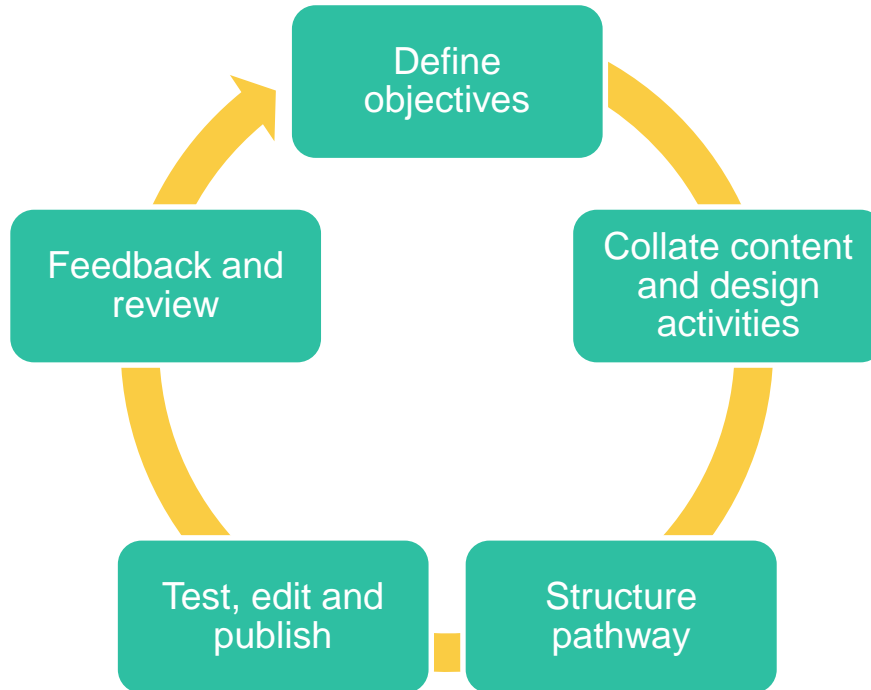
